
ACTIVE IN MINISTRY WITH SPIRITUAL GIFTS FLOWING

- We are all called to tithe as our Christian responsibility but it does not mean that we all have been called as ministers of the giving.
- We are all called to pray as our Christian responsibility, but that does not mean that we all have the supernatural call as ministers of intercession.
- We all are also instructed in Colossians 3:16 to teach and admonish one another as our Christian responsibility.
- We are to be disciplined and skillful enough in the word to disciple others but this type of teaching is different from the call and anointing of God upon ministers of teaching.



Let us learn to recognize and edify one another as specific ministers and let us learn to appreciate the unique and different gifts from God that we all have.
